If you have a job that calls for 5/8" sheetrock that doesn't require a fire rating of more than 30 minutes (i.e. interior office walls) you might want to consider using <u>USG's</u> <u>Firecode30</u>. It is an ultralight type product that is 30% lighter than regular 5/8" Firecode board but at the same price. While we don't stock the Firecode 30, we can bring it in with any of our loads-usually with just a couple days notice.

Commodities update:

- It's that time of year to start thinking about the annual gypsum price increase which will occur on January 1, 2015. Some manufacturers have already announced a 20% increase. Although USG, our main gypsum vendor has not yet made any official announcement, we wouldn't be surprised if it was less than 20%.
- USG <u>did</u> put out an increase letter for <u>gypsum finish products</u> (joint compound, etc.) and <u>plasters</u> of 5% effective October 6.
- Essroc our <u>bagged portland</u> and <u>masonry cements</u> vendor, will increase their product on January 1, 2015 by \$.50/bg and \$.40/bg respectively.
- ABC and Fabral, one of our <u>metal roofing/siding</u> vendors, have increased pricing by 5%
- <u>Panel products</u>: <u>OSB</u>, while still at low prices and has been for over a year, has shown some signs of movement upward, although it is not substantial. <u>SYP plywood</u> continues to be extremely expensive! With dealer and wholesaler inventories very low, the mills are in the driver's seat for now.
- <u>Dimension Lumber</u>: <u>Eastern/Western spruce</u> and <u>inland/white fir</u> markets are showing signs of falling, nothing drastic and possibly only short term, but falling nonetheless.
