(Ilion) 	 <u>Metal studs</u> and accessories as well as <u>metal lath</u> and related items will increase effective September 22, 2014. Increase amount, if it sticks, may be as much as 10%. It is doubtful this will stick. IKO is announcing a 6-8% increase in <u>roof shingle</u> prices for 09/08/14. It is doubtful that retail prices will be affected this year. USG has announced the next improvement to the drywall line with the introduction of <u>Imperial Ultralight</u> in 1/2" thickness. Plans are to have a rolling change over from the regular weight product to the new product in September and October. Panel products - <u>OSB</u> remains steady to up only slightly while <u>SYP plywood</u> is stubbornly holding on the very high prices it has gained over the last month. <u>Dimension lumber: SPF</u> and <u>Fir</u> products are trading at pretty high prices with no real let up in sight. <u>SYP treated lumber</u> has been steadily and noticeably increasing throughout August which is very unusual.
