Clean surface to remove wax, dirt and other foreign matter. Scrape off any loose or peeling paint. Patch cracks and nail holes. Dull glossy areas with gloss remover or sandpaper. Spot prime water stains with Valspar<sup>®</sup> Latex Stain-Blocking Primer before priming the entire surface.

#### Bare wood:

*Interior* - Sand wood smooth and patch holes and imperfections with wood filler or putty and sand smooth. Remove all sanding dust. New or bare surfaces must be primed with Medallion Interior Latex Primer.

*Exterior* - Remove sap from knots and sappy areas and spot prime before with Valspar<sup>®</sup> Medallion<sup>®</sup> Exterior Oil Primer before applying a full coat of this product. Sand wood smooth and patch holes and imperfections with wood filler or putty and sand smooth. Remove all sanding dust. Prime new or bare surfaces.

#### Masonry and cement:

First remove all loose or sandy material, dirt, grease and oil with an all-purpose cleaner (TSP) before priming the entire surface.
