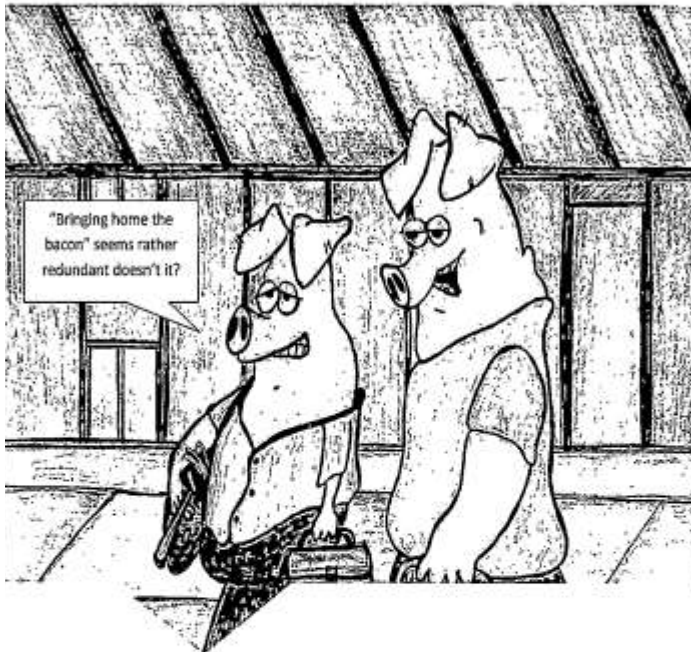

## Commodities Update:

- As of this writing, the big topic of interest is the sudden demand for treated lumber and its resultant large spike in price. During the initial stage of the virus many yellow pine mills cut back on production in anticipation of reduced demand and presumably for worker safety. Now that the good weather has come about and many homeowners are stuck at home their thoughts turn to outdoor home improvements-hence the demand for deck building treated lumber. Treeters have been telling us they have never seen demand this strong. I've been thinking that treated lumber's the new toilet paper phenomenon with everyone clamoring for it! The situation may last 6 to 8 weeks or more. Decking and timbers may be in scarce supply for the duration of this heightened demand.
- Drywall plants are starting to experience higher order volumes and their deliveries are starting to back up from customary lead times. It's not yet to controlled allocation levels yet, but worth planning ahead still.
- We're seeing panel products-OSB and SYP plywood much more active as well. Anticipate price increases for both types of products as construction projects resume nation wide.
- Dimension lumber (SYF) has seen moderate increases but not of the degree seen with treated or panels.
