Commodities Update:

- Dimension lumber: pricing for SPF lumber, after an extreme drop in price over the last 10-12 weeks, still is not sure what direction it is headed. There are some signs it will fall further and others that it will start inching back up. We'll have to wait and see what happens. SYP lumber (treated) already seems to have hit bottom and is heading up- ward.
- Panel products: <u>OSB</u> and <u>SYP plywood</u> have made their correction in the marketplace. We're no longer seeing the \$70 plus prices on 7/16" and ½" CD at retail. In fact, retails have fallen by more than half that price. Again, it's too early to tell whether prices will get back to our usual or whether they'll have any substantial increase. Huber products (<u>Advantech</u> and <u>Zip</u>) has taken a hit in price levels, but still has not decreased as much as the commodity panels have.
- USG will raise prices on a number of products again this month-on 9/13:

<u>Drywall</u> increase is announced as 20% (will most likely be only \$.02/SF though)

Securock sheathing 40% (most likely \$.03-.04/SF)

<u>Interior finishing products</u> (Compound, tape, plaster, etc) 15%.

Paperfaced and metal trims 10%.

- We're still seeing huge increases on metal products due to a world wide shortage (reportedly). Among those again is <u>steel studs</u> which will increase another 10-15% early this month. Steel studs have been in extremely short supply with much longer than usual lead times.
- Johns Manville will increase <u>fiberglass</u> <u>insulation</u> prices on 9/1 by 8% again. We will increase retails early in the month.
- Big Timber will take it's second price increase this year on 10/1. We will hold our prices as long as we can, but will raise them by late October/early November.
- Ply Gem will again raise vinyl prices on 9/1 by 10-12% including vinyl siding, skirting, PVC trim and shutters.


