

Commodities Update:

- Panels: OSB seems to have hit its bottom prices for now, having fallen around \$100/M very quickly, but it seems to be working its way back up. SYP plywood had a few flat weeks and with order files out 2-3 weeks, we may see the market stabilize at these numbers for the time being.
- Dimension lumber: Our Euro SPF prices continue to slowly reduce and just when you think it can't go lower, it does. I don't imagine it will go much lower, though, (have I said that before?) because mills will cut production to stop further price erosion. SYP lumber (our PT species) has had a number of weeks of reductions in most dimensions.
- The gypsum price increase expected for 10/16/23 has been deferred for now. Our main vendor has promised a thirty day notice if the increase is reinstated.
- Bagged Portland and Masonry cements will increase by \$.60 and \$.40 per bag respectively effective 1/1/24.
- The 6% fiberglass insulation increase scheduled for 11/1/223 has been postponed also.
