Commodities Update:

- Panels: <u>OSB</u> has officially reached its bottom in this past month and is working its way steadily upward. <u>SYP plywood</u> seems to be in a holding pattern, not up or down significantly.
- Dimension lumber: <u>SPF</u> has seen some price hikes in each of the last few weeks. With better weather coming, it would not be surprising to see further increases. <u>PT</u> <u>lumber</u> has seen strong increases for the last 3-4 weeks and is expected to maintain these levels for the next few months.
- The <u>fiberglass</u> and <u>Rockwool insulation</u> shortage continues. It may be 3 or even 4 months more before the situation improves.
 We caution you to plan ahead for your insulating needs.
- Roofing manufacturers have announced a 4 6 % increase in shingles for 4/1/24.

Life lesson 668

It was the Summer of 2009 at the age of fifty five that I was diagnosed with cancer of the prostate gland. Yes, it is truly the news you never want to hear from your doctor. In the midst of doing the research for treatments, Sue and I kept the news to ourselves and continued our ordinary lives. Work was still a priority, the kids were all in the "moved/moving out of the house and setting up their own households" phase of their lives and Sue and I maintained a "business as usual" approach to each day.

I tell you this because, as I have told others who have received similar diagnoses, it may have been one of the best things I've ever experienced. There are questions about life- your own life especially- that you can never really ponder and answer without having a life threatening crisis such as this.

I wondered what kind of person I'd find myself to be. Would I handle the situation like the people of my Dad's generation with quiet strength and determination or would I fall overboard with emotion and create unnecessary drama and attention?

Also, I took a good long look back at my life up to that point and of gave myself a grade in case things went downhill from there. Was I satisfied with the person I thought I'd become, or as Ebenezer Scrooge in A Christmas Carol, find that I needed to make wholesale changes? Or was it somewhere in between?

I wondered, too, if I'd discover the people that were truly my friends; who truly cared for me. (Spoiler alert: yes, I did discover that- both positively and negatively). Let me tell you, it is really important to know who your true friends are at this time in your life.

There was a good deal of anxiety in leading up to the treatment and surgery and in dealing with the recovery, but as I look back now at that unique time in my life, I see what an incredible blessing it was. It was a time to step back from the life I'd lived, to look at where I'd been, what I'd built and with whom, to breathe it all in deeply- the joys, the losses, the beauty, the disappointments- and then calmly exhale with a new perspective, to step forward again, gratefully, into the rest of my life.
