Commodities Update:

- Panels- OSB has seen a slide down this month but many who are “in the know” feel the bottom of this market is approaching quickly. SYP plywood, on the other hand, has seen modest jumps in price most weeks this month.
- Dimension lumber- SPF pricing has somewhat stalled this month, partially due to inclement weather of the past few weeks. SYP (pressure treated) has been on the increase for the last month or more, despite the wintry weather.
- The USG drywall increase deferred from last month has now been set for 2/3/25. While we haven’t gotten a firm answer, we expect the cost to raise \$.02/SF. USG did go up on joint treatments. We will adjust our retails in the coming weeks. Durock cement board did not increase.
- Knauf, our primary fiberglass insulation manufacturer, has deferred indefinitely, their price increase that was scheduled for 2/1/25.
- USG Interiors will raise prices on both ceiling tile and ceiling grid by 6-8% and 9% respectively 1/31/25.
- Trim-Tex, our vendor for vinyl drywall trims, will increase 3% on 2/11/25.
- GAF has announced a 6-10% increase on residential roof shingles on 4/1/25. They are still not producing their full offering of colors.
- Larson Door will go up 5% on storm door costs on 2/3/25.
