### **Commodities Update:**

- Dimension lumber: <u>SPF lumber</u>, by all expert accounts, is heading in an upward direction. The last few weeks have seen modest increases and when the antidumping and countervailing duties take effect on Canadian import lumber we will see a 20% increase right away. The US Commerce Dept has still not announced a firm date for the imposition of these duties but it will be sometime between July 24 and mid-September. <u>SYP / PT lumber</u> has seen an uptick in dealer purchases with small increases week over week. Timbers are expected to rise more quickly in the next few weeks.
- Panels: <u>OSB</u> still remains flat and is still a great value.
  Both <u>SYP</u> and <u>D Fir plywood</u> report soft sales with pricing still flat.
- Metal products: <u>Mesh</u> and <u>rebar</u> expect to see a 5-7% increase in the market. USG Interiors <u>ceiling grid</u> will increase 5% on 8/11/25.
- Acoustical ceiling panels from USG Interiors will increase 7% on 8/1125 also.
- Our main <u>housewrap</u> supplier, Alpha ProTech, announced a 10% increase for both tariff and transportation reasons late this month. We'll monitor the situation before we raise our retail prices.
