

### **Commodities Update:**

- General economy- Forecasters predict we won't see any significant growth in the construction sector until interest rates fall below 6%. The Federal Reserve has not moved rates down because of concerns over inflationcaused predominantly by potential tariff effects on the economy.
- Dimension lumber- <u>SPF</u> saw slight increases as of this writing (mid-June) but is still lingering on the low side of trading levels. With summer mill shutdowns approaching and countervailing duties to be imposed on Canadian lumber imports in August, the market won't remain at this low level for long. <u>PT lumber</u> is still awaiting its traditional uptick at this time of year. Lack of demand due to rain here in the East, among other factors, is contributing to this market situation.
- Panels- <u>OSB</u> remains a great deal. Prices are very low and while expected to turn back up, has not happened yet. <u>SYP plywood</u>, likewise, has seen single digit drops and would be a good purchase now for customers in need.
- Insulation products- <u>Rockwool</u> price increase 8-16% (our stock products will most likely be closer to 8%) effective 7/7/25.
- Roofing products: Most <u>shingle</u> manufacturers are either on controlled allocation or out 6-8 weeks on orders.
- Metal products- Clark Dietrich and other manufacturers will raise <u>steel stud</u> prices on 7/1/25. Increase percentage yet to be determined. With tariff concerns, <u>rebar</u> and <u>mesh</u> are starting to see small/medium increases. Fasteners- <u>screws, structural fasteners, nails even metal hardware items</u> like National Hardware products are increasing noticeably.
